

Covid-19 – Current Guidelines

- Anyone attending a venue (including players, coaches, staff and any other visitors), should undergo a pre-attendance self-assessment for any COVID-19 symptoms using the information on the NHS website before leaving home.
- No-one should leave home to participate in tennis if they, or someone they live with, has symptoms of COVID -19, currently recognised as any of the following:
 - A high temperature
 - A new, continuous cough
 - A loss of, or change to, their sense of smell or taste
- Should an individual have demonstrated any such symptoms, they must follow NHS and PHE guidance on self-isolation
- If you have played at Bracknell Lawn Tennis Club and develop symptoms of COVID-19, you should follow the Government's 'test and trace' guidelines, which can be read on the Gov.uk website
- Players should observe the 2-metre social distancing rule at all times
- The clubhouse is accessible for the toilets, floodlight switches, first aid kit and to purchase drinks from the bar. There should only be one customer at the bar at a time and those waiting should queue outside.
- Singles and Doubles Play is permitted, players playing doubles do not have to be from the same household.
- Any organised sessions by the club must be pre-booked.
- Members may now organise their own mix-in sessions involving a maximum of 6 players.
- All courts must be booked in advance through the court bookings system. Players should arrive dressed for tennis.
- Players should bring with them:
 - Ample supplies of water or other drinks.
 - Your own tennis balls (you should mark them for identification).
 - Hand sanitiser to clean hands after touching shared surfaces.
 - Gloves – it is advised to wear gloves when using the drag mats.
- Do not use the court score boards.
- Return balls to a neighbouring court without touching them.
- Juniors under 16 must be supervised an adult at all times.
- Please leave the main gate open while there are players at the club. Last player out please ensure the main gate and car park gates are both closed as normal.
- The ball machine must not be used.
- Please take your rubbish home with you.
